The workshop non only helped to inform and clarify the administrative procedures for the good management of individual projects byut as well to make the different project coordinators aware of the interconnections and cross-polinizations expected among the three different types of funded projects. Additonally, for an overall benefit, each single project was given an opportunity to briefly pitch it attending to a pre-standardised set of slides focusing on the main objectives of the project and the type of interaction that the project was seeking with piers.


